APA Referencing

THIS IS A QUICK GUIDE TO THE APA REFRENCING STYTLE (7TH EDITION)

- The American Psychological Association Reference style uses the author-Date format.
- Refer to the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (7th ed.) for more information.
- Check Library Catalogue for call number and location(s).
- When quoting directly or indirectly from a source, the **source must be acknowledged in the text** by author name in year of publication.

IN-TEXT

To cite information directly or indirectly, there are two ways acknowledged citations:

1. Make it a part of the sentence or 2. put it in parentheses at the end of the sentence.

Direct quotation – use double quotation marks around the quote and include page numbers

- 1. Fowsar and Rameez (2014) argue that "many different kinds of abilities are essential for any profession" (p.151).
- 2. "Many different kinds of abilities are essential for any profession" (Fowsar & Rameez, 2014, p.151).

N.B See the Library's APA webpage for a quotation of 40 or more words.

Indirect quotation/paraphrasing/summarizing - no quotation marks

- 1. Professional knowledge alone does not make someone a very capable professional (Fowsar & Rameez, 2014).
- According to Fowsar and Rameez (2014), professional knowledge alone does not make someone a very capable professional.

N.B. Page numbers are optional when paraphrasing, although it is useful to include them (Publication Manual, p.171).

Citations from a secondary source

- 1. Ayoob's (1981) research "raises fundamental doubts as to whether we can continue to think of intelligence as unidimensional" (as cited in Fowsar & Rameez , 2014, pp.151-152).
- 2. Intelligence cannot be believed to consist of one single entity any more (Ayoob, 1981, as cited in Fowsar & Rameez, 2014).

N.B. To cite a source you found in another source, you must acknowledge all the authors.

• The author(s) of the source referred to

- i.e. Ayoob, 1981
- The author(s) of the work which contains the original source i.e. Fowsar & Rameez ,2014

In the reference list, only the book by Fowsar & Rameez should be acknowledged. Do not list Gould.

• At the end of your assignment, you are required to provide the full bibliographic information for each source. References must be listed in alphabetical order by author.
