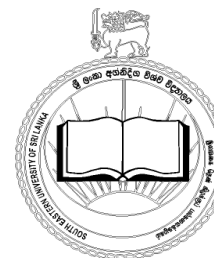

Introduction

The redesigned Bachelor of Arts (General) External Degree Programme as an integrated program incorporates various subjects fields such as Geography, Economics, English, Philosophy, Political Science, Sociology and Tamil. The programme is being offered by Faculty of Arts and Culture, and implemented through Centre for External Degrees and Professional Learning (CEDPL), South Eastern University of Sri Lanka.

The BA degree programme is structured to reflect the changing world and provide a firm foundation for the world of work. It offers the necessary academic subjects in the fields of humanities, social sciences, ethical principles and general studies that influence decision making in a social environment.

Entry Requirements

Minimum qualification for the entry to BA (General) degree (external) shall be:

1. At least three passes in all three approved subjects in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) where a minimum marks of 30% or the marks which is determined by UGC in Common General Test. UGC will issue minimum Z score on an annual basis. This Z score will be used to determine the eligibility of candidates to follow the external degree programme.

Or

2. Any other qualification acceptable to the Senate of SEUSL and in accordance with

section 3.1 of the UGC Sri Lanka, handbook on External Degrees and Extension Courses, 1st December, 2010.

Duration and Flexible Structure of the Programme

The duration of the programme (Bachelor of Arts – BA (General) is three academic years, with two semesters per academic year. Each semester will have duration of a minimum fifteen (15) weeks.

For each course units there will be in-course assessment and end semester written examinations. End examination shall be held at the end of each semester. The students should complete the degree within 6 years from the registration. The results will be released semester wise.

The programme is redesigned in a flexible manner so as to suit the convenience and requirements of the students. If a student is unable to continue further or wishes to suspend the studies for any reason he / she will be awarded one of the following.

1. **Certificate in Arts** – A certificate in Arts upon the successful completion of first year of study.
2. **Diploma in Arts** – A diploma in Arts upon the successful completion of second year of study.

Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction is Tamil.
