- 2. Lakadasa Wikkramasingha goes native in his poetry. It is the rural life that becomes the subject of his poems. Do you agree? Discuss with reference to the poem 'From the Life of the Folk Poet Ysinno'.
- 3. Discuss the salient features of Romanticism with reference to Wordsworth's 'I Wandered lonely as a cloud' and 'The Solitary Reaper'.
- 4. a) Anne Ranasinghe's poetry is full of compassion for the suffering. Discuss this in relation to the poems 'Plead Mercy' and 'On the Beach'.

b) "W.H. Auden's 'The Unknown Citizen' is a satire on standardization at the expense of individualism." Do you agree?
