Description:

1. CCTV at South Eastern University of Sri Lanka:
South Eastern University of Sri Lanka has a robust security system both on and off campus. CCTV surveillance systems are installed throughout the facilities, and the university's security officials monitor the area 24 hours a day to strictly avoid the crimes and misbehaviors of all individual attached to university.
2. Fire Hydrant and alarming systems at South Eastern University of Sri Lanka:
SEUSL has effective alarm systems in place to respond to accidents, fires, and crimes, and it assists employees in safeguarding themselves and taking preventative measures to minimize damage or halt occurrences.



3. Emergency lights:

Emergency lighting systems have been built on university property to keep the campus illuminated in the event of power outages or unexpected power failures, and to assist the institution in avoiding dangerous situations when such incidents occur.

4. Natural disaster alert system:

The Disaster Management Center of Sri Lanka has placed natural disaster and tsunami alert alerting devices quite close to the SEUSL main campus at Oluvil. This will enable the institution to implement necessary mitigation and preventive measures in a timely manner and to educate staff about catastrophes.
