KALAM is a multidisciplinary, refereed biannual international research journal of the Faculty of Arts and Culture of the South Eastern University of Sri Lanka. It aims to encourage multifaceted, multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary researches on Humanities and Social Sciences.

Volume 16, Nos. 1 & 2 will be published in July 2023 and December 2023 respectively. Both issues will accept research articles in both English and Tamil for publication if submitted in the following manner.

GUIDELINES

Types of Article for Submission: All formatted, full-text articles received should contain original, previously unpublished research results. Findings of both experimental and theoretical studies would be considered for publication.

Manuscripts are accepted on the understanding that they have not been published elsewhere and are not currently under consideration by another journal. The submitting author is responsible for ensuring that all the other co-authors have approved the publication of the article. It is also the authors' responsibility to ensure that articles originating from a particular institution are submitted with the approval of that institution. Only an acknowledgement from the editorial office officially establishes the date of receipt of the submission. Before publication, further correspondence and proofs will be sent to the author(s). It is a condition of acceptance of a paper that the author(s) allow editing for improved readability. All enquiries concerning the publication of accepted manuscripts should be addressed to the Co-Editors-in-Chief of KALAM.

Peer Review Process: All manuscripts are subjected to a peer-review process to determine if they meet the criteria for scientific significance and academic excellence. A submission will first be scrutinized by the Co-Editors-in-Chief, and if he/she approves of same, it will be passed on to be judged by peer-reviewers, whose identities will not be disclosed to the author(s).

If the paper can be accepted subject to certain changes, then the author(s) will be requested to incorporate the changes suggested by the reviewers. The Co-Editors-in-Chief will then review the revised manuscript after the changes have been made by the author(s). Once he/she is satisfied with the amended manuscript, the accepted paper will be published on a final decision made by the editorial board.

Title and Authorship Information: The following information should be included.

1. Title of paper
2. Full name of the author(s)
3. Name of the institute and name of the department
4. Name of the Country
5. E-mail addresses of the author(s)

Abstract: A concise abstract outlining in a single paragraph (amounting to not more than 200 words - line space: single) must contain the paper's aim, scope, and conclusion.

Keywords: Immediately following the abstract, a maximum of five keywords must be given in alphabetical order (avoid words like 'and' & 'of'). Use abbreviations sparingly - only abbreviations firmly established in the relevant field are permitted.

Structure of Main Text: Manuscripts must be set out in the following order - Title, Authors, Affiliations, Abstract, Keywords, Introduction/Background, Problem Statement, Objective(s), Methodology, Literature Review, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, References, Acknowledgements, Appendix, References, Figure Captions, Figures, and then Tables.

Copyright: All authors must sign the 'Transfer of Copyright Agreement' before the article can be published. This 'Transfer Agreement' enables the publishers to protect the copyrighted materials on behalf of the authors but not void the authors' proprietary rights. The copyright transfer covers the exclusive rights to reproduce and distribute the article, including reprints, photographic reproductions, microfilm or any other reproductions of similar nature and any translations. Proofreading is solely the author's responsibility. Any queries should be answered in full. Authors must correct factual errors and any errors introduced during typesetting.

The guidelines and other important dates:

- **For English text:** Garamond font - size 11
- **For Tamil text:** Akarathi font - size 11
- **Line Space:** 1.5
- **Word Limit:** A manuscript should be around 4000 to 5000 words and not exceed 6000 words, including references and endnotes.
- **Referencing Style:** APA 7th Edition (2020)
- **Deadline:**
 - Submission deadline for the Issue No. 1 is **April 30th**. Notification on or before May 31st. (early submissions are encouraged).
 - Submission deadline for the Issue No. 2 is **September 30th**. Notification on or before October 31st. (early submissions are encouraged).
