

### **Abstract Guideline**

**Title:** The manuscript's first page must include the paper's title, the full name(s) of the author(s), position(s), and affiliation(s). It should also provide the contact author's name, affiliation, address, phone number, and email address.

**Abstract:** The abstract should be structured to include the following sections:

- Purpose: Clearly state the objectives and aims of the research.
- Design/Methodology/Approach: Describe the research design, methodology, or approach used in the study.
- Findings: Summarize the main findings or results of the research.
- Practical Implications: Explain the implications of the findings for practice.
- Research Limitations: Acknowledge any limitations of the research.
- Originality Value: Highlight the unique contribution of the work.

**Keywords:** Provide keywords that reflect the core themes of the paper

### **Formatting**

**Title:** Must be concise and indicative of the content of the abstract. Use boldface, capitalize each word, and center the title at the top of the page.

**Author Details:** List each author's full name, academic or professional title, affiliation, and contact information. The presenting author's name should be underlined.

**Font and Size:** The abstract must be typed in Times New Roman, 12-point font size, and single-spaced to ensure readability.

**Margins:** Ensure that the document has 1-inch margins on all sides.

**Length:** The abstract text should not exceed 250 words, keeping it succinct and focused on the key points.

**Structure:** Organize the abstract under the following subheadings:

- Purpose
- Design/Methodology/Approach
- Findings
- Practical Implications
- Research Limitations
- Originality/Value

**Keywords:** List 3-5 keywords that accurately reflect the content of your paper immediately after the abstract.

**File Format:** Submit your abstract in Word File format to facilitate further formatting.

**Language:** All abstracts must be written in English, which is the symposium's official language.

**Submission:** Abstracts should be submitted via CMT link or [intsymseusl@seu.ac.lk](mailto:intsymseusl@seu.ac.lk) by 29<sup>th</sup> December 2023.
