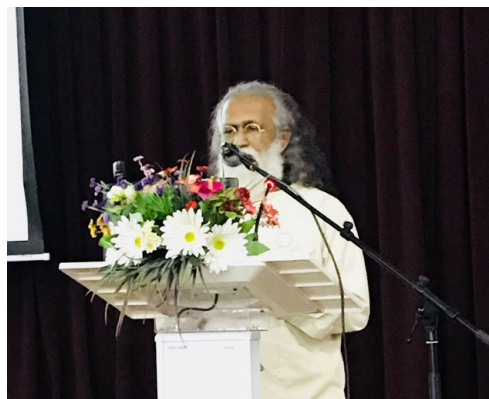

SCHOLARSHIPS

Mrs. MM Mashroofa, Acting Librarian, SEUSL has got a scholarship to visit USA for IVLP on “American Libraries- a multi-regional project”, from 17th July to 28th July, 2017. Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, US Department of State sponsored her visit and the programme was administered by ‘World Learning’. The aim of this program is to examine the wide role and functions of libraries and information specialists in US society, explore the importance of community based partnership strategies for promoting sustainability and community services, demonstrate the diversity of library services in the digital age, explore the impact of online technologies on various types of libraries and examine the role of libraries in eliminating the digital divide. She visited the first three days at Washington, D.C, district of Columbia between States of Mary Land and Virginia, the second three days at New Orleans, Lusiana, third three days at Phoenix, Arizona and the last three days at Chicago, Illinois. Library of Congress, several university libraries, public libraries and museums were included in her visit. She said indeed, American libraries are not only repositories of books and databases; they serve as community centers for diverse populations, information hubs for local entrepreneurs and immigrants, catalysts for civic education and engagement and as champions for youth and free speech.





Dr.A.Rameez, Head/Department of Sociology, FAC, underwent a scholarly invaluable program or training on 'Religious Pluralism' at the Dialogue Institute of Temple University in the United States of America for 6 weeks from June to August, 2017. 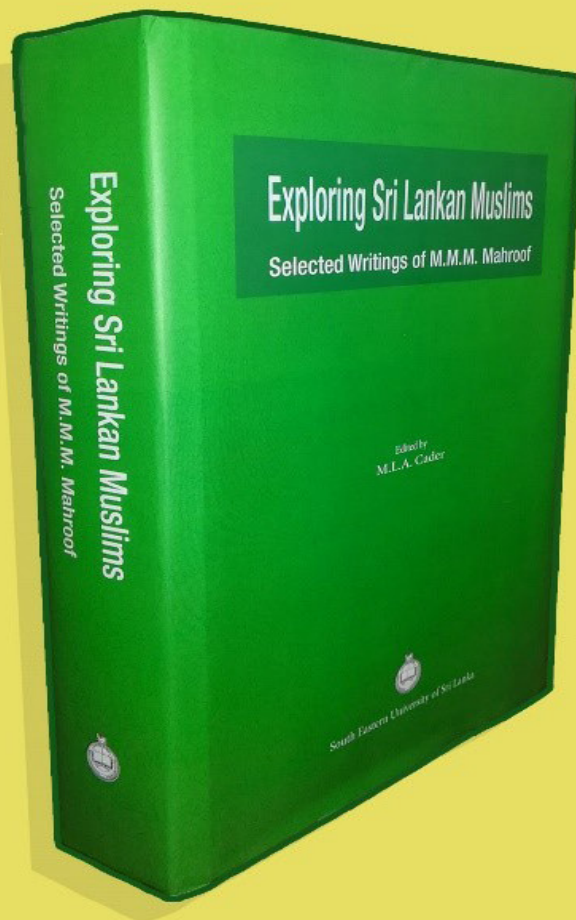


COLLECTION OF ARTEFACTS AND RARE MATERIALS

About the Author: M.M.M. Mahroof (1932-2000) received his early education in a Quran Madrasa and his secondary education at Hameedia School and Zahira College, Colombo. He read for his Honours degree in Economics with Sociology as a subject at University of Ceylon. He was a teacher for many years at Zahira College, Colombo and joined the Department of Muslim and Religious Affairs as a Senior Assistant Director in 1981 and retired in 1988. He served as a member of several National Committees: Cultural Policy, Madaras Education, Lexicography and Sahithiya Academy. His research articles on the Origin and Decline of Tamil fiction in 1971 and the Story of the Crescent serialized in *Thinakaran* weekly edition received wider acclaim. His publications include *Ethnological Survey of Muslim of Sri Lanka* (1986), *A Short History of the Muslims of Anuradhapura District and Kalutara District* (1992) and *Introductory Readers on Muslim Leaders* (1980). He received state honours as Kanzul Uloom in 1992.
