A Lecturer (Unconfirmed) [Non (Medical/Dental) I, who has completed the three year period of satisfactory service and the induction training course within a period of one year from the date of appointment, may be confirmed in the post of Lecturer [Non-(Medical/Dental) 1, provided such Lecturer has fulfilled all other requirements specified in the letter of appointment.
2. The confirmed Lecturer [Non-(Medical/Dental) J may be considered for promotion to Senior Lecturer Grade II [Non-(Medical/Dental)] upon fulfilling 5 years of experience (along with the experience as defined under Post No 06) and satisfying the other requirements as specified in the Scheme of Recruitment under Post No. 07 of Commission Circular No. 721.
